Unit of Inquiry: Where We Are in Place and Time **Central Idea**: History impacts who we are today.

Lines of Inquiry:

- How people lived in the past (form).
- Beliefs and traditions that are valued today (connection).
- Historical events that have impacted on society (causation).

English Language Arts:
