**Unit of Inquiry**: Where We Are in Place and Time **Central Idea**: History impacts who we are today.

**Lines of Inquiry:** 

- How people lived in the past (form).
- Beliefs and traditions that are valued today (connection).
- Historical events that have impacted on society (causation).

## **English Language Arts:**

- Daily 5 Throughout the literacy lesson, students are reading to themselves, reading to a friend, working on their writing independently, listening to reading and practicing making words. Students are also reading with their teacher in small groups.
- Writing: Students are writing <u>opinions</u>. They are writing how they feel about something and reasons to support why they feel this way. For example: "I like this book because..."
   "I do not like this book because..."
