Unit of Inquiry: How the World Works

Central Idea: People create solutions to changing landforms.

## Lines of Inquiry:

- Identify landforms on a map.
- Factors that change landforms.
- Features of a solution.

#### **Teacher Questions:**

In Grade 2 we are trying to find the answers to the following questions:

- 1. What is a landform?
- 2. What is a map?
- 3. How does a landform change?
- 4. Why do we need solutions?
- 5. Is there always a solution?

## **English Language Arts:**

- Daily 5 Throughout the literacy lesson, students are reading to themselves, reading to a friend, working on their writing independently, listening to reading and practicing making words. Students are also reading with their teacher in small groups.
- Writing: Students are learning to write *procedures*. Procedures explain how to do something. For example, how to play a game or following a recipe. Please follow this link to our Grade 2 website for more information <u>procedure writing</u>.
- Grammar: Present and past tense. A present tense verb means the action is taking place now. Past tense refers to verbs where the action has already happened. For example: He went to the show. Went is past tense. I jumped on my bed. Jumped is past tense.
