# Grade 2 Weekly Overview Week 19: January 25th – 29th

Unit of Inquiry: How We Express Ourselves

Central Idea: Stories are told in different ways and for different purposes.

#### Lines of Inquiry:

- Different ways of telling stories (form).
- Elements of a story (form).
- How different stories connect to our own lives (connection).
- The responses that stories can evoke (perspective).

### **English Language Arts:**

- Daily 5 Throughout the literacy lesson, students are reading to themselves, reading to a friend, working on their writing independently, listening to reading and practicing making words. Students are also reading with their teacher in small groups.
- Writing: Students are learning to write *narratives*. Narratives tell a story. They are written to entertain and evoke responses in the reader, listener or viewer.
- Grammar: Adjectives. Adjectives are describing words. They describe the noun. For example:
  - o It is a <u>cold</u> day.
  - o <u>That</u> cat belongs to Sara.
  - o I have <u>black</u> hair.

Phonics: -ch

Spelling: mother, answer, found, study, much, such, search, march, story, stories
