## **English Language Arts:**

- Daily 5 Throughout the literacy lesson, students are reading to themselves, reading to a friend, working on their writing independently, listening to reading and practicing making words. Students are also reading with their teacher in small groups.
- Writing: Students are learning to write *narratives*. Narratives tell a story. They are written to entertain and evoke responses in the reader, listener or viewer.
- Grammar: Action Verbs. Action verbs are doing words. They are actions.
  - o I am running fast.
  - o The plane is <u>flying</u> high in the sky.
  - o I ate eggs for breakfast.

**Phonics:** Adding –es to words.

**Spelling:** boxes, foxes, dishes, mixes, brushes, wishes, washes, fixes, different, purposes
