Unit of Inquiry: Who We Are

Central Idea: People contribute to the community in different ways.

Lines of Inquiry:

- Characteristics of the community in which we live (form).
- My responsibilities as a member of a community (responsibility).
- Skills and attitudes used to resolve conflicts (function).
- The importance of a shared vision toward a common goal (connection).

English Language Arts:

- Recount Writing: Who? When? Where? What? Students are learning to write recounts in the correct order.
- Daily 5 – Read to Self: Students are learning how to read their books independently.

Phonics: /ai/

Spelling: little, work, know, place, rain, wait, paint, paid, goal, family.

Math:

- Writing numbers in the correct order.
- American currency – counting coins (penny, nickel, dime, quarter)
- Telling time to the nearest half hour.
- Recall basic math facts (for example: $3+3=6$, $4-2=2$)
